- 3. Announcement of Christian Raffensperger as Program Committee chair for 2020 (Ben Anderson)
- 4. Ad Hoc Committee Business (Ben Anderson):
 - a. IT Committee: Reminder of Thursday discussion of website quote, which generated queries to send to Emmanuel. However, committee has basically disbanded.
 - b. Call for Additional Policies: Hate speech policy and/or comparative study of how our current discrimination policy compares to those of other organizations, in light of AIA last year (Fotini)
- 5. New Business:

a. Program Committee: Christian Raffensperger seeks advice on inclusion of undergraduate abstracts, size of program committee, percentage of graduate student papers.

Motion to oppose undergraduate submission of abstracts. Proposed, Galina; seconded, Lynn. Motion passed.

Size of Program Committee: Current policy = 5 people, but had recently grown larger. Board affirmed that policy should be followed. 5 people on committee.

Graduate student papers at BSC: percentage cap considered, given financial considerations (Ballard/Jones report), combined with encouraging post-graduate scholars to submit more abstracts.

Board proposal: graduate student cap of 20-25 papers to be accepted any given year. Abstract submission to include a question: Do you have a PhD at the time of submission?

Adjustments to EZ-Chair to allow submission of panels approved.
